EDUCATION AGENCY RELATIONS GOALS

The Board will cooperate to the fullest possible extent with other school districts and with other local, state, and regional agencies and organizations in the solution of educational problems of common concern. This cooperation will extend to such areas as research, contracting for services, exchange of information and data, coordination of curriculum, coordination of school calendars and activities, and construction of facilities that may be efficiently used on a cooperative basis, and any other activity where it may be advantageous to serve a broader area than the member school districts.

In carrying out this policy, the Director will include in his or her recommendations to the Board an evaluation of the desirability and feasibility of cooperation with other agencies in endeavors which could benefit the cooperative.

STUDENT TEACHERS, INTERNS AND PRACTICUM STUDENTS

The Board endorses participation in undergraduate programs with colleges and universities for the purpose of training competent future teachers, therapists and school psychologists. The Director is encouraged to cooperate with institutions in placement of these individuals within the cooperative's member school districts. In accepting and placing these individuals, the Director shall consider local school needs including qualifications and interests of available cooperating supervisors. These individuals will be accepted on a limited basis and placed according to availability of competent cooperating supervisors.

The Board authorizes the Director to approve unpaid prospective individuals as described above. All paid positions must be approved by the Cooperative Board and participate in all regular employment requirements. Unpaid positions may be approved by the Director and a criminal background check will be completed if not completed by the institution placing the student.
