Student Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) for Internet and Network Systems

Purpose & Scope

This policy applies to students enrolled in the CORE Independent Center Transition Program. It ensures that students use technology in a respectful, responsible, and safe way. All students are expected to follow this policy when using school computers, tablets, Chromebooks, and internet access for learning, job readiness, communication, or work-related activities.

Responsible Use

Students are expected to:

- Use technology for learning, training, or job-related activities as directed by school staff.
- Keep their usernames and passwords private.
- Immediately report any inappropriate content or problems to staff.
- Use respectful language in all online communication.
- Handle devices and equipment with care.

Not Allowed (Prohibited Activities)

Students may NOT:

- Use technology for personal or entertainment purposes without permission.
- Access, download, or share inappropriate content (including explicit or violent materials).
- Use social media unless it is part of a school-approved activity.
- Share private information (such as address, phone number, or passwords).
- Try to bypass internet filters or access blocked websites.
- Use another person's account or identity online.

School Monitoring

All student use of school technology is monitored by CORE staff. Students should not expect privacy when using district-provided technology or accounts. Staff may review student activity at any time to ensure safety and policy compliance.

Consequences

If a student does not follow the rules in this policy, consequences may include:

Loss of access to school technology.

- Additional disciplinary action in line with the CORE Independent Center program expectations.
- Meetings with family or guardians.
